CONTRACT:

- I understand the dance season runs from September 2017 to May 2018, consisting of a minimum of 34 sessions per discipline (including picture days and rehearsals) during the nine-month term. The year concludes with the year-end show “Reflections 2018” at TCU Place. Tickets will be available through tcutickets.ca.
- I understand that competitive students must attend **ALL competitions**. Perfect attendance is mandatory the last week of lessons before competing.
- I understand that I will not miss more than 3 classes, and will let the studio know if missing in advance.
- **Lessons are to be paid by nine post-dated cheques, September to May, and may be dated for the 1st, 15th or 20th of each month, covering all lessons within the month.**
- I understand that refunds are not given for missed classes, and that there are no make-up lessons for missed classes.
- **I understand that one month’s written notice is required if discontinuing a discipline. In the event that a class/ discipline is discontinued AFTER the costumes have been ordered, I will be responsible to pay for the costume(s) in full.**
- In registering with Brenda’s School of Baton & Dance I understand that the student I am registering is not allowed to dance at another dance studio without permission from the director, Brenda Bennett.
- Brenda’s School of Baton & Dance reserves the right to use photos of students for social media purposes, only the first names of dancers will be used.
- Cheques returned due to stop payment or non-sufficient funds are required to be replaced in a timely fashion with an additional charge of \$25.00 (NSF fee).
- Cheques are payable to *Brenda’s School of Baton & Dance*. (We have a stamp).

REGARDING ACCOUNTS:

- A costume deposit for each class is added to the monthly lesson amount.
- Exam entry fees must be paid at the time of registering for the exam.
- If your dancer is in a competitive class, Festival fees will be charged to your account, once per year for each Festival entered.
- Private lessons are only available to those students whose accounts are in good standing.
